

SPRING CLEAN-UP 2022

The City and Borough of Sitka announces its Annual Community Wide Spring Clean-Up

**TRANSFER STATION, 205 JARVIS STREET
WILL BE OPEN THE FOLLOWING TIMES DURING THE SPRING CLEAN-UP:
SATURDAY, April 23rd through SUNDAY, May 1st - 8 AM to 4 PM**

All **RESIDENTIAL** property owners are encouraged to clean up their property and haul all acceptable refuse to the Jarvis Street Transfer Station **FREE OF CHARGE** during **SPRING CLEAN-UP**. No batteries, paint, or metals. Commercial waste will be charged at the standard rate. Dump trailers cannot be used. Spring Clean-Up garbage bags can be picked up at the Fire Hall.

**SAWMILL COVE RECYCLING CENTER (SCRAP YARD)
GARY PAXTON INDUSTRIAL PARK, 4655 SAWMILL CREEK ROAD
WILL BE OPEN THE FOLLOWING TIMES DURING SPRING CLEAN-UP:
SATURDAY, April 23rd through SUNDAY, May 1st - 8 AM to 4 PM**

Junk vehicles, scrap metal, water tanks, refrigerators (**must be cleaned of food**), dryers, washing machines, stoves, aluminum boats, boat trailers, outboards, and lower units (**shall be drained of oil**), properly cleaned fuel tanks accepted, and unbroken residential fluorescent bulbs will be accepted **FREE OF CHARGE**. Commercial waste will be charged at the standard rate.

Vehicles $\frac{3}{4}$ ton rated or smaller will be accepted free of charge. **The inside of vehicle must be clean of all garbage**. Oversized vehicles such as RVs and buses, rated 1 ton or larger, will be charged at the standard rate and accepted by scheduled appointment only. No heavy equipment will be accepted during this event.

Vehicles MUST be accompanied with a Title OR a notarized 849 DMV form to be accepted.

**HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION AT
THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT – 100 ALICE LOOP
SATURDAY, April 30th - 8 AM to 4 PM and SUNDAY, May 1st - 8 AM to 3 PM
LAST WEEKEND ONLY**

Household Hazardous Waste will **NOT** be accepted at the Transfer Station or Sawmill Cove Scrap Yard. This includes oils, chemicals, solvents, antifreeze, cleaners, poisons, herbicides, acids, automotive & boat batteries, flares, and paints. Note: automotive & boat batteries can be taken to NAPA Auto Parts- Sitka Motor Supply at any time during the year.

RECYCLABLES / RESIDENTIAL YARD WASTE / JUNKED BOATS

Recyclables – Residents are encouraged to recycle all glass, tin cans, aluminum, #1 and #2 plastics and corrugated cardboard at the Recycling Center, located at 802 Sawmill Creek Road (across from the National Cemetery).

Residential Yard Waste -This location has changed from the left side of 401 Granite Creek Rd to the right side. **Follow the signs**. Up to 5 cubic yards of residential yard waste per customer will be accepted **FREE OF CHARGE weekends only** during Spring Clean-Up, **April 23rd & April 24th - 8 AM to 4 PM and April 30th & May 1st - 8 AM to 4 PM** (pick-up truck loads only). Commercial operators' waste is not part of Sitka's Spring Clean-Up and must be paid for. Yard waste includes brush, overburden, stumps, & green waste.

Junk Boats – Will be charged at the standard rate according to size. Boats must be clean of any debris including engines, outdrives, fuel tanks etc. **METAL BOATS** will be accepted at the Sawmill Cove Scrap Yard. **WOODEN or FIBERGLASS BOATS will be accepted at the Sitka Landfill by approval and appointment only**.
