The City and Borough of Sitka announces its Annual Community Wide Spring Clean-up

## 205 JARVIS STREET TRANSFER STATION

**WILL BE OPEN THE FOLLOWING TIMES DURING THE SPRING CLEANUP:**

**SATURDAY, April 18<sup>th</sup> through SUNDAY, April 26<sup>th</sup> - 8 AM - 4 PM**

All **RESIDENTIAL** property owners are encouraged to clean up their property and haul all acceptable refuse to the Jarvis Street Transfer Station **FREE OF CHARGE** during **SPRING CLEANUP**. No batteries, paint or metals. Unbroken residential fluorescent bulbs will be accepted **FREE OF CHARGE (no commercial)**. Commercial waste will be charged at the standard rate.

Spring Clean Up yellow garbage bags can be picked up at the Fire Hall.

## SAWMILL CREEK SCRAP YARD

**WILL BE OPEN THE FOLLOWING TIMES DURING SPRING CLEANUP:**

**SATURDAY, April 18<sup>th</sup> through SUNDAY, April 26<sup>th</sup> - 8 AM - 4 PM**

Junk vehicles, scrap metal, water tanks, refrigerators, dryers, washing machines, stoves, aluminum boats, boat trailers, & properly cleaned fuel tanks accepted **FREE OF CHARGE**.

Vehicles ¾ ton rated or smaller will be accepted free of charge. The inside of vehicle must be clean of all garbage. Oversized vehicles such as RVs and buses, rated 1 ton or larger, will be charged at the standard rate and accepted by scheduled appointment only. No heavy equipment will be accepted during this event.

**Vehicles MUST be accompanied with a Title OR a notarized 849 DMV form to be accepted.**

## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION – **NEW LOCATION** FOR 2020

**113 JARVIS STREET – FOLLOW THE SIGNS**

**SATURDAY, April 25<sup>th</sup> - 8 AM – 4 PM and SUNDAY, April 26<sup>th</sup> - 8 AM – 3 PM**

**LAST WEEKEND ONLY**

Household Hazardous Waste will **NOT** be accepted at the Transfer Station or Sawmill Cove Scrap Yard. This includes oils, chemicals, solvents, antifreeze, cleaners, poisons, herbicides, acids, automotive & boat batteries, flares, and paints. Note: automotive & boat batteries can be taken to Napa at any time during the year.

## RECYCLABLES / RESIDENTIAL YARD WASTE / JUNKED BOATS

**Recyclables** – Residents are encouraged to recycle all glass, tin cans, aluminum, #1 and #2 plastics and corrugated cardboard at the Recycling Center, located at 802 Sawmill Creek Road (across from the National Cemetery).

**Residential Yard Waste** - Up to 5 cubic yards of residential yard waste per customer will be accepted **FREE OF CHARGE** at the **Granite Creek Waste Area**, 401 Granite Creek Road (left side) **weekends only** during Spring Cleanup (April 20<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup>) from 8 A.M.- 4 P.M. (pick-up truck loads only). Commercial operators' waste is not part of Sitka's Spring Cleanup and must be paid for. Yard waste includes brush, overburden, stumps, & green waste.

**Junk Boats** – Will be charged at the standard rate according to size. Boats must be clean of any debris including engines, outdrives, fuel tanks etc. **METAL BOATS** will be accepted at the Sawmill Cove Scrap Yard. **WOODEN or FIBERGLASS BOATS will be accepted at the Sitka Landfill by approval and appointment only.** Contact PW Maintenance Shop at (907) 747-4041 to schedule disposal at the Sitka Landfill.
